Love for God: Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. Matthew 22:37	This person loves Jesus passionately, which increases a passion for Jesus in others by just being around him/her.					
Love for People: And the second is like it; "Love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:39	This person loves others deeply and sacrificially and does well at making others feel valued and appreciated.					
Humility: ...in humility consider others better than yourselves. Philippians 2:3b All of you clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud and gives grace to the humble." 1 Peter 5:5	This person demonstrates a submissive spirit toward God and a submissive and encouraging spirit toward others.					
Integrity: The integrity of the upright guides them, but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity. Proverbs 11:3	This person has an adherence to moral and ethical principles and a soundness of moral character and honesty that glorifies Jesus.					
Consistency: For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love, and of self-discipline. 1 Timothy 1:7 Let us not become weary in doing what is good... Galatians 6:9	This person glorifies Jesus with a steadfast adherence to a course of action that benefits both self and others.					
Authenticity: These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. 1 Peter 1:7	Through Jesus, this person demonstrates a genuine attitude around others and encourages authentic behavior in others.					
Trustworthiness/Responsibility: I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength, that he considered me trustworthy, appointing me to his service. 1 Timothy 1:12 Well done, my good servant! his master replied. 'Because you have been trustworthy in a very small matter, take charge of ten cities.
